

2020 Schedule of Fees

Annual Tuition Fees

The following fees and charges have been approved by the Avila College Board for 2020. The fee charged per student is inclusive of College camps and excursions, leasing costs associated with provision of a College laptop, and any software licences required. These fees are to remain fixed throughout the year unless significant and unforeseen circumstances arise.

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Early Payment Discount

A discount of \$320 per student will be granted when all fees are paid in full to the General Office by Friday 28 February 2020 (close of business - 4pm). Please note late payments will not be entitled to the discount.

VET Electives

Some student VET fees may need to be passed onto families. In these instances, the fees are in addition to the total College Annual Tuition Fees. Please note any government funding received by the College will be deducted from any VET fees charged. If additional fees are payable, Parents will be notified in writing prior to the beginning of the year.

Re-enrolment Levy (Current Students)

In Term 4 each year parents of students in Years 7 to 11 will be asked to confirm their daughter's enrolment at the College for the following year, together with a payment to confirm their place. This deposit will be deducted from the following years' Annual Tuition Fees. Please note this fee is non-refundable should the student not return to the College as expected in the following year, and parents are asked to complete permissions and re enrolment payment by the requested date.



Extra Curricular Activities - International Language and Cultural Tours

Various student trips are offered annually. All costs associated with these trips are additional to the College Annual Tuition Fee charged. For students to participate in these trips, it is expected families will be on a full fee scheduled payment plan and their Annual Tuition Fee account is not in arrears. Parents of students whom apply to attend these trips will receive a letter to identify the costs and methods of payment associated.

Damage Excess on College Macbooks

Avila College maintains a 1:1 Macbook program where devices are leased by the College, and loaned to the student to support learning for the duration of their education at Avila. In the event damage is sustained to the device, the College will notify the family if the repairs are not covered by the Apple warranty. An excess of \$250 is payable by families on any repairs required outside of the laptop warranty. The amount will need to be paid within 7 days of the notice being issued.

Payment in Full by the end of the School Year

It is a College expectation that all family accounts are to be paid in full by the end of the school year. Student enrolment at the Avila College is based on, among other factors, understanding and acceptance of the College Fee Policy, available on the College website www.avilacollege.vic.edu.au
