TESTING



Students will be provided with a pack of 5 rapid antigen tests.

2 TIMES A WEEK



It is recommended that students test themselves at home twice a week on school days.



TEST RESULTS



NEGATIVE

If you return a negative test attend school as normal.



POSITIVE

If you return a positive test please follow the 3 Step Process below.



STEP 1

Report your test online to the Department of Health

STEP 2

Inform Avila that you have tested positive via www.avila.vic.edu.au/inform

(Note: All details recorded remain confidential)

STEP 3

Isolate at home for 7 days (inclusive of weekends) and do not attend school during this period.

HOUSEHOLD CONTACTS

You have spent more than four hours with someone who has COVID-19 inside a house.

STEP 1 Inform Avila that you are a household contact at www.avila.vic.edu.au/inform (Note: All details recorded remain

STEP 2 Quarantine at home for 7 days (inclusive of weekends) and do not attend school during this period.

CONTACT AT SCHOOL

confidential)

A student has been in contact with a case of COVID-19 at school or at work.

If asymptomatic, students should continue to attend school & monitor for symptoms.

If symptomatic, students must stay/return home and take a test. On receipt of a negative result, and if well enough, the student can return to school.
