## SHB30221 CERTIFICATE III IN MAKE-UP - VET IN SCHOOLS

Classes held: Wednesdays from February to November

This qualification reflects the role of individuals employed as make-up artists to design and apply make-up for a range of purposes and occasions across the beauty, fashion, media and entertainment industries.

These individuals possess a range of well-developed technical and consultation skills where discretion and judgement are required and are responsible for their own outputs. This includes working cooperatively with a range of individuals including photographers, fashion stylists and media production staff.

Work is typically conducted as part of a team or on a freelance basis in settings such as make-up studios, retail cosmetic counters, fashion and media sets and photography studios.

You will learn practical skills to deliver a variety of make-up looks including make-up for day, evening, bridal, fashion and glamour occasions.

Students attend elly lukas I day per week, or for VCE students a half-day (plus burst weeks), on Wednesdays to complete 9 units from the SHB3022I Certificate III in Make-up qualification in the 1st year with the option to continue with the 2nd year to complete the remaining 6 units in order to gain the SHB3022I Certificate III in Make-up qualification.
