Certificate II in Apparel, Fashion and Textiles

VET Delivered to Secondary Students

Entry requirements: Enrolled as a VCE or VCE (Vocational Major) student at a Victorian secondary school. **Career opportunities:** Learners may gain employment into entry level positions such as product sourcing and retail/online sales. This course may assist in creating a portfolio for further study.

INTERIOR DECORATION AND DESIGN Certificate III in Interior Decoration Retail Services

VET Delivered to Secondary Students

Entry requirements: Enrolled as a VCE or VCE (Vocational Major) student at a Victorian secondary school. **Career opportunities:** Work in interior decoration retail outlets.

CARPENTRY AND JOINERY Certificate II in Construction Pathways

VET Delivered to Secondary Students

Entry requirements: Enrolled as a VCE or VCE (Vocational Major) student at a Victorian secondary school. **Career opportunities:** Carpentry apprentice, joinery apprentice, bricklaying apprentice, tiling apprentice, painting and decorating apprentice.

CARPENTRY AND JOINERY

VET Delivered to Secondary Students

Certificate II in Building and Construction Pre-Apprenticeship (Carpentry)

Entry requirements: Enrolled as a VCE or VCE (Vocational Major) student at a Victorian secondary school. **Career opportunities:** Carpentry apprenticeship, building trade apprenticeship.

ELECTRICAL

Certificate II in Electrotechnology (Career Start)

VET Delivered to Secondary Students

Entry requirements: Enrolled as a VCE or VCE (Vocational Major) student at a Victorian secondary school. This course requires at least Year 10 mathematical knowledge, and is not recommended if you find mathematics at this level challenging.

Career opportunities: Apprentice electrician, apprentice electrical fitter, apprentice air conditioning and refrigeration mechanic, renewable energy systems installer, electrical engineering technician, renewable energy sales and support roles.

ENGINEERING AND FABRICATION Certificate II in Engineering Studies - Fabrication

Entry requirements: Enrolled as a VCE or VCE (Vocational Major) student at a Victorian secondary school. **Career opportunities:** Heavy earth moving equipment, mining equipment, pressure vessels, pipework, automotive/truck body building, duct work, shipbuilder/boats/submarines, aircraft, structural work, electrical switchboard cabinets.



Certificate IV in Tertiary Preparation

Entry requirements: To be eligible for the program, applicants must be at least 17 years old. Career opportunities: Intake worker, client assessor, aged care nurse, palliative care nurse, rehabilitation nurse, mental health nurse, acute care nurse, family services, youth and case management ,juvenile justice, disability support, family violence, homelessness services, community worker, outreach worker.

VCE - Victorian Certificate of Education, Trades Academy

Entry requirements: Learners must be 16 years of age at the 30th of April to be eligible for enrolment. Learners under the age of 17 must have a completed Exemption form School form, authorised by the learner's previous school principal. This is a requirement under the Ministerial Order 705. Permission may also be required under this same act, to receive permission from the Department of Education's regional director (the learner's previous school seeks this permission, when relevant).

Career opportunities: Entry level positions within industry specific streams that the learner has studied.

GENERAL EDUCATION

Victorian Pathways Certificate



Entry requirements: There are no formal entry requirements for VPC studies. However, students are required to attend an interview with a parent or carer to determine their suitability for the course. Students must be 19 years old and have additional learning support needs or a letter of recommendation from a doctor or allied

Career opportunities: Open or supported employment opportunities, traineeships and apprenticeships.

Certificate I in Developing Independence

Entry requirements: You must be at least 16 years of age and be prepared and ready to commence this program within 2 weeks of moving into the Glen Waverley campus Youth Foyer. Career opportunities: Entry level positions in the hospitality industry.

Certificate I in General Education for Adults - Switch Program

Entry requirements: You must be at least 15 years old and enrolled in school at the time of commencement. Career opportunities: You will develop specific employment skills whilst completing various projects throughout the program, all of which are designed to boost their confidence, communication skills, coping mechanisms and life skills, whilst being able to enter employment in areas such as retail or hospitality.

Certificate I in Work Education

Entry requirements: You must be 16 years of age by 30 April 2026 to be eligible for enrolment. Students $under the age of 17 \ must have a completed \ Exemption \ From \ School \ form, authorised \ by \ the \ student's$ previous school principal.

Career opportunities: Entry level positions in a variety of fields/industries, using 'VET skills sets' students have acquired (completed) as part of their VCE VM program, in addition to entry level positions in retail or hospitality.
